PPPC Evaluation and Rating Policy(2023)

- 1. 2.0/2.5 SELF-RATING: PPPC members may participate in any club sponsored play including but not limited to weekly round robin play, all levels drop-in and tournaments (both non-sanctioned and sanctioned) with a self-rating level of 2.0 & 2.5.
- 2. 3.0 & ABOVE RATINGS: PPPC members who wish to participate in any club sponsored play including but not limited to weekly round robin play, all levels drop-in and tournaments (both non-sanctioned and sanctioned) at a rating level of 3.0 and above must have earned a club and/or tournament rating. These ratings need to be established by June 1st of the current year or 30 days from date of membership renewal(if renewed after May 1st). If this is not accomplished, you will remain at your current level or be moved down a level(if not rated) in club play.
- 3. PPPC members may play down in any scheduled play that has a '+' following the rating number. This permits play for those who wish to play with their spouses/partners.
- 4. TOURNAMENT RATINGS: PPPC members may enter any tournaments (sanctioned and non-sanctioned) at whatever their CTPR(CanadianTournament Player Rating) or UTPR (US Tournament Player Rating) is. CTPR is generated through pickleballbrackets.com. For new players who do not have a CTPR or UTPR they should set up their profile at the level they feel they are competitive at. Over time these will adjust based on their tournament play results. This will be totally independent of their Club Rating. Club Play will be based on their Club Level or their CTPR or UTPR whichever is higher. Exceptions Members' Only or Members' Fun Tournaments would have all members participate at the level they play in club scheduled play.

5. INCREASING RATINGS: PPPC members who wish to move up to a higher level must either increase their official tournament rating with tournament play and/or successfully demonstrate the increased skill level by participation in a club approved rating clinic. Currently, PPPC is accepting rating evaluations from EVPC(Edmonton Volleyball Pickleball Center). PPPC will not accept DUPR(Dynamic Universal Pickleball Rating) or self-ratings for club play.
